MENTORING

To enhance Nowshera Medical College student's performance, foster educational environment, and achieve the institution's mission, the Medical Education Department at NMC has introduced a mentoring program aimed at fulfilling the long-term objectives of both the department and its students. The mentors at NMC are notably skilled and dedicated, developing learners' leadership and communication skills, promoting their personal, professional growth, and supporting their career advancement.

The program is founded on the following policies:

- The program is founded on a foundation of mutual respect between mentors and mentees.
- 2) The program is built on trust and a confidential relationship between the mentor and mentee.
- 3) The program's primary goal is to foster student growth by guiding them in the right direction and consistently monitoring their progress.
- 4) Mentoring relationships are designed to achieve the mentee's specific developmental goals while maintaining the organization's values and requirements.
- 5) Mentors demonstrate exemplary behavior, offering mentees opportunities to observe and develop their own vision.
- 6) Mentors act as supportive companions, encouraging self-reflection.
- 7) The program includes a feedback system to reinforce and enhance learning.
- 8) The mentoring relationship concludes when the mentee has developed the ability to function autonomously.
- 9) It is the duty of all mentors to assist their mentees in completing feedback forms related to modules, basic sciences teaching and clinical sciences teaching.
- 10) Attendance should be recorded based on the submission of these forms.

Furthermore, a copy of the attendance shall be sent to the Department of Medical Education to allow the Chairperson DME to verify whether students who marked their attendance have submitted the required forms. If the forms are not submitted, the
